Presenter, Anumantha Kanthasamy, M.S., M.Phil, PhD.
Anumatha Kanthasamy's research on the cellular and molecular mechanisms of Parkinson's disease and other neurodegenerative disorders has established him as a leading neuroscientist and distinction to Iowa State University. His studies focus on environmental, chemically induced neurodegenerative processes capable of producing Parkinson's disease, and the development of novel therapeutic agents to treat neurodegenerative diseases. He has made several fundamental advances in signal transduction mechanisms associated with cell death processes in Parkinson's disease.
